



## **ABM Janitorial Services Awarded Contract with Lambert-St. Louis International Airport**

SAN FRANCISCO – June 17, 2005 – ABM Janitorial Services, an operating unit of ABM Industries Incorporated (NYSE:ABM), has been awarded a multi-year, multi-million dollar contract renewal with Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (STL). The contract covers janitorial service for all common areas throughout the airport concourses, which encompass approximately 290,000 square feet.

Lambert employs more than 19,000 people through airlines, vendors and service companies, as well as the City of St. Louis, which owns and operates the airport.
